## Custom care for the patient and family

Each family's situation is unique, beginning with the patient's physical condition and state of mind. Our multidisciplinary approach — carried out by teams of physicians, nurses, social workers, counselors and volunteers — is designed to address each family's needs and desires, from specialized pain management and pastoral support for terminally ill patients, to family support and counseling. Other unique features and options include the ability to serve home-cooked meals, 24-hour visiting, lodging and transportation for family. Complementing traditional medical services are such alternative therapies as reflexology, music, art and pet therapy.

The inpatient hospice unit of Hebrew Hospital Home is located in a beautiful campus setting in the heart of Westchester County.

**From the Sprain Brook Parkway,** take the Eastview exit (Rt. 100C), turn eastbound (becomes Grasslands Rd.). The entrance to HHH of Westchester campus is approximately 1 mile east of the Sprain Brook Parkway (at the bottom of a hill and on a slight curve), on the south side of Grasslands Rd.



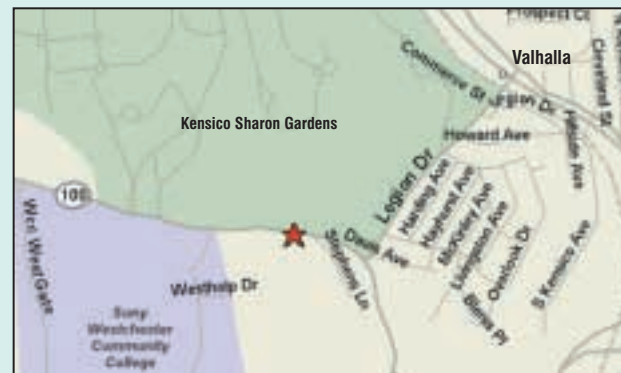

## For the patient

- Warm, home-like atmosphere
- Beautiful, serene setting in the heart of Westchester County
- Team of experts — physicians, nurses, social workers, counselors, volunteers — trained in end-of-life care
- Palliative care available for pain and symptom management
- Reflexology, music, art and pet therapy
- Jewish, Catholic, and Protestant clergy members make regular visits and hold religious services on a weekly basis and on religious holidays

## For the family

- Opportunity to serve home-cooked meals to patients
- Special family lounge areas and comfortable lounge chairs in patient rooms for long visits
- Extended visiting hours for family and friends, up to 24 hours
- Additional rooms available for family lodging at a nominal fee, approximately half the price of area hotels
- Transportation available for family members to and from facility
- Convenient to public transportation
- Extended bereavement and counseling services available for family and friends
- Cost is covered by Medicare, Medicaid and most private insurance plans
